
PLEASE READ

There have been reports from December 2019, of multiple cases of pneumonia caused by a new strain of the coronavirus in Wuhan, China (the suspected origin of the virus).



Measures are already being taken to quarantine the virus. However, since this new strain of coronavirus has an incubation period in the human body of up to 14 days, symptoms may appear even after leaving Wuhan.

If you have visited Wuhan, China, <u>especially in the past two weeks</u>, please read below.

• If you have symptoms such as; coughing, a fever, etc. please wear a mask and visit a medical facility. Please contact the facility before visiting.

• During your visit, please tell the medical practitioner that you had recently visited Wuhan, China.

There is currently very little threat from this new strain of coronavirus. Please remain calm. However, as it is the time of the year when it is easy to catch the common cold and the flu, please make sure to: **wear masks**, **wash your hands** as often as possible, and to continue to follow hygienic practices to prevent from becoming sick.
