Multiple cases of a new strain of virus (the coronavirus) have been occurring in the Wuhan, China since December 2019. A patient in Aichi Prefecture was confirmed to have the virus on January 26th, 2020. This is the first case of the coronavirus in Aichi Prefecture.

Please make sure to: wear masks, wash your hands as often as possible, and to continue to follow hygienic practices to prevent contracting the virus.

If you have visited Wuhan, China in the past two weeks, please read below.

If you have symptoms such as; coughing, a fever, etc. please wear a mask and visit a medical facility. Please contact the facility before visiting. During your visit, please tell the medical practitioner that you had recently visited Wuhan, China.

Through cooperating with other institutions, the City of Nagoya will continue to update you with information as quickly as possible.

Coronaviruses can cause infectious diseases in humans and animals. There are currently 6 strains of coronavirus that are known to affect humans.
